

# Error M1108 Script Field XML Parser

## Message

When attempting to print a label template which contains a script, an error similar to the following is displayed:

(M1108) Error with Script field 'suppress\_script': XML Parser Error: '-0.0540' violates pattern constraint of '[0-9]\*[.]?[0-9]\*'.

The attribute 'posTop' with value '-0.0540' failed to parse.

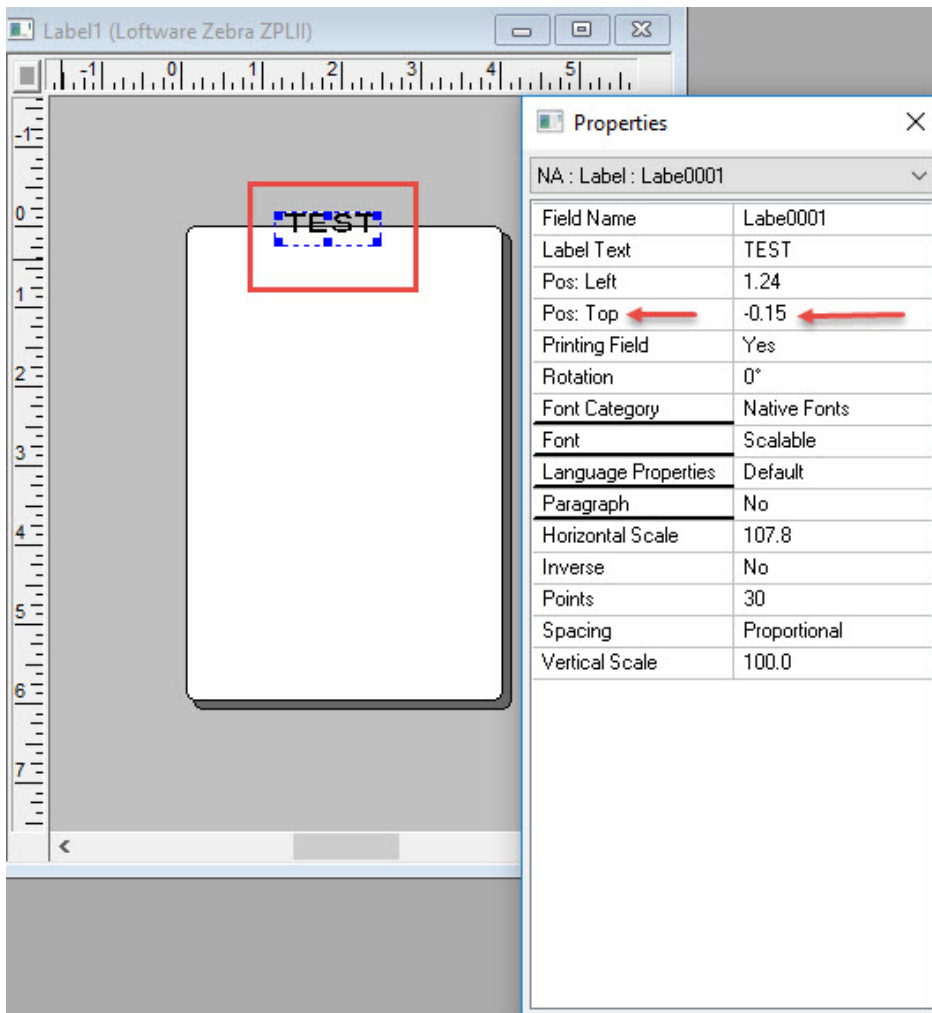
## Explanation

In this example, the field name in question is "suppress\_script". As the error message indicates, the XML Parser generates the error because a character found in the value is not in the list of valid characters for that property (the pattern constraint). In this case, the Position Top field property ('posTop') contains a negative sign, but only the characters 0 through 9, comma, and period are recognized as valid characters.

If a negative value is displayed in the **Pos: Top** property, then field is located partially or fully off the label canvas as shown in the following image.

## Environment

Any supported LPS family product environment



## Solution

To resolve this error, move the appropriate field fully onto the label canvas so the **Pos: Top** property is a positive value. The label prints as desired once this is complete.
